TRAINING PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Need of segregation of generated waste.
- Advantages of Reducing, Reusing and Recycling the generated waste to the maximum
- Precautions to be taken to maintain Health and Hygiene
- Importance of the usage of the accessories given or provided during the training programme.
- The importance of the education and family planning.

- Department of Environment conducted Training programmes for 4500 rag pickers during 2007-08 and 7000 during 2008-09 on waste management.
- Training the women ragpickers in making value added products out of the waste is continuing
- Article like shoes, apron, groves and marks for their safety were provided to all the rag pickers.
